DOM Thoughts,

As I write this article I do so with a heart filled with EXCITEMENT as well as a heart that is DEEPLY BURDENED! The excitement comes from that fact that in just a few weeks Kathy and I will be Grandparents! I cannot describe to you how excited we are as we await the arrival of our first Grandchild. We were asked recently what we wanted our Grandchild to call us – for Kathy would it be Me Ma or Ma Ma or something else? For me was it going to be Pa Pa, Poppa or Pops? My immediate response was that I want to be called "Cool Pops" because I plan on being the coolest Grandpa in the world. (Aren't we all?) So yes, my heart is filled with EXCITEMENT!

My heart is also deeply concerned – concerned about what kind of world our Grandchild will grow up in. Over the past twenty to thirty years our country has been engaged in a CULTURE WAR! Ed Stetzer (LifeWay Research) said "Ten years ago we were talking about who would win the culture war, and now we're talking about how will Christian rights be protected after the culture war." He goes on to say that we (Christians) have lost our home field advantage and things are going to be quite different in the days ahead. Dr. Robert Jeffress, Pastor of First Baptist Church Dallas stated that "Christians are losing the culture war and that we are losing ground every day." He goes on to say that "The primary reason Christians are losing the culture war is because many Pastors are AWOL when it comes to informing and energizing their congregations." I read recently that there are approximately 80 million evangelicals in America and only 40 million of them are registered to vote. It was estimated that of the 40 million evangelicals registered to vote in the last election only half of them actually participated in the electoral process. And we wonder why we are losing (or have lost) the culture war for the heart and future of America! My heart is burdened as I think about the effects of this culture war on our children and grandchildren? It has been stated that the Pastor who follows today's Pastor will probably see the tax-exempt status removed from churches and his successor will go to jail for preaching God's Word.

So I close where I began, my heart is about to leap out of my chest as we await the arrival of our first

Grandchild – but at the same time I wonder what kind of country/world will he grow up in. It's time to wake up Church and get busy being the salt and light that God intends for us to be. It's time for the church to begin impacting the culture rather than allowing the culture to impact the church!


