The first week in October 2015 saw the worst flooding on record for the state of South Carolina. The "thousand year flood" has been blamed for at least 19 deaths; 372 closed roads and bridges and 17 dam failures. Oconee County was one of the few counties spared and for that we give thanks!

As BBA reached out to our churches on behalf of our state's Midlands and Coastal areas, you responded in an extraordinary way! It is estimated that the total monetary value of

money, water, and other miscellaneous items donated was well over \$15,000. Below are some pictures of the donations that poured in along with the wonderful volunteers who helped to load them on the trucks bound for North Trenholm Baptist Church in Columbia, SC on Friday, October 9. We are thankful for the following men who delivered the water and supplies to the designated distribution point: Ken Reid, Ronnie Wald, Gary Wilson and Mike Wright.



A Celebration of What God Has Done

The end of the Civil War, the assassination of President Abraham Lincoln, and the establishment of Pleasant Ridge Baptist Church north of Walhalla, each of these events occurred in the year of 1865. On Sunday, September 27, 2015, Pleasant Ridge celebrated all that God has done there in the past 150 years.

Pleasant Ridge Baptist was started with a small handful of men and women who paid the Rev. Milton Morton \$5 and two twists of tobacco. They shared their first pastor with two other local churches as part of a circuit. There were good years and years of struggle. In one of the hard years, Pleasant Ridge

considered closing its doors and probably would have if it had not been for the pleas of a young girl, Malinda Ranken, who begged the adults not to shut the doors of the church she loved so much. Because of the love and devotion of this young lady who allowed God to speak through her, Pleasant Ridge is still sharing the gospel and loving on people today.

Rev. Frank Thomas (1976-79) was the guest pastor and Rev. Ray Campbell (1953-55, 1997-2006) gave the closing prayer. Also attending were state senator, Thomas Alexander, Oconee County sheriff, Mike Crenshaw, and Walhalla's mayor, Danny Edwards, who was raised at Pleasant Ridge and Director of Missions for Beaverdam Baptist Association, Rev. David Shirley. As part of the ceremony, Senator Alexander presented Pastor Michael Welch (2006 - present) with a "Certificate of Appreciation" from the

South Carolina State Senate recognizing the achievement.

Though there was some ceremony to the day, primarily it was a celebration of what God has done, is doing, and is going to do. There was a lot of rejoicing when Pastor Welch was able to announce that not only was the mortgage for the education building paid off, but God had already provided a considerable amount for what He has for Pleasant Ridge's future in ministry. Before fellowshipping around the table after the service, Bob Edwards (life-time member and Deacon Emeritus) and Harold Welborn (Chairman of the Deacons and head of the building committee that built the education space) burned the note! Though Pleasant Ridgers look gratefully on the memories of what God has done, they look with even greater excitement for what God has in store for the next five, ten, and 150 years.

- One 4 oz. bar of soap
- One junior legal or no larger than 5 1/2" x 8" writing tablet (no wire bound and no 9x12)
- Five first-class **Stamp- Embossed** #10 envelopes
 (purchased at US Post Office)
- Two rolls of candy (LifeSavers, Mentos, BreathSavers type)
- 1 gallon size Ziploc (zipper) bag to place above items in
