We were thrilled to share with our pastors in January that the Beaverdam Baptist Association has officially entered into an agreement/partnership with Fortitude Consulting, Counseling & Supervision Services to provide our member churches with licensed, professional Christian counseling services. Fortitude CCSS is located at 530 By-Pass 123, Suite E-2, Seneca, SC 29678. (Next to Copper River restaurant in Seneca). Providing our churches with a licensed, professional counseling resource has been one of our goals since the retirement of Dr. Bill George and the closure of the Oconee Counseling Center several years ago.

Beaverdam Baptist Association pastors will now be able to refer people through the association to Fortitude CCSS for licensed, professional Christian counseling. The guidelines that have been established for access to this counseling ministry have been established in cooperation with Fortitude CCSS as well as our associational executive and personnel committees.

I am excited that we as an association now have this incredible resource available to our pastors and churches. I do ask that you please be patient with us as we enter into this partnership. We begin this partnership realizing that the guidelines will probably need to be tweaked as we move forward.

Beaverdam Baptist Association Counseling Referral Guidelines

1. The counseling services funded by the Beaverdam Baptist Association and provided through Fortitude Counseling are available only to Beaverdam Baptist Association affiliated churches.
2. Requests and approval for counseling referrals must be made by Beaverdam Baptist Association Pastors through the Director of Missions Office. The person(s) being referred to

Fortitude will remain anonymous and will not be made known to the Director of Missions.

3. Clients being referred must be affiliated in some way with a Beaverdam Baptist Association church.
4. Once approval has been given by the Director of Missions the referring Pastor will inform the client that it is their responsibility to schedule an appointment with Fortitude Counseling.
5. Clients must take the Counseling Referral Form (Given to the requesting Pastor by the Director of Missions) to Fortitude Counseling, 530 By-Pass 123, Suite E-2, Seneca, SC 29678 in order to make the appointment.
6. Appointments are scheduled ONLY through the office at Fortitude Counseling. The Beaverdam Baptist Association DOES NOT schedule appointments through our office.
7. The cost per session is \$125.00.
8. The Beaverdam Baptist Association will pay \$100.00 for each session.
9. The client will be responsible for paying \$25.00 per session.
10. The client will also be responsible for providing Fortitude Counseling with a credit card.
11. If the client fails to show for a scheduled appointment without a valid excuse, they will be responsible for the total cost of the session. The \$125.00 session cost will be charged to their credit card.
