From The DOM,

As we enter the month of October that means it is time for the Annual Meeting of the Beaverdam Baptist Association! This year's meeting will be held on Sunday, October 22 at Return Baptist Church. Pre-session music will get underway at 5:45 led by Return Baptist Church. The speaker for this year's meeting will be Dr. Jimmy Boggs (Ebenezer Baptist Church). This year a recommendation will be made to accept THREE new churches into membership of the Beaverdam Baptist Association. It is my hope and prayer that the messengers to this year's annual meeting will celebrate the addition of Christ Fellowship (Pastor Josh Thomas), Grace Baptist Church (Pastor Chuck Cook), and La Roca Oconee (Pastor Edson Garcia). The Beaverdam Baptist Association has not had a church apply for membership since Mt. Tabor Baptist Church in 1998 and prior to that Golden Corner Church in 1996. What an incredible blessing it is to have three churches desiring membership into the Beaverdam Baptist Association.

In September, I was blessed to attend the 2023 AMS (Associational Missions Strategist) Summit held at the North American Mission Board in Alpharetta, Georgia. This year we were blessed to hear from Dr. Brent Leatherwood, the president of the Southern Baptist Convention's Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission. The Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission is an entity of the Southern Baptist Convention. The Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission exists to assist churches by helping them understand the moral demands of the gospel, apply Christian principles to moral and social problems and questions of public policy, and to promote religious liberty in cooperation with the churches and other Southern Baptist entities. The focus of Dr. Leatherwood's presentation dealt with "Religious Liberty and a Sexually Confused Age." I will be sharing much of the information that was presented with our pastors in the days ahead. A major emphasis was placed on the importance of churches making sure that their current by-laws contain statements clarifying the church's position on marriage, gender, and sexuality. This is critically important as we seek to minister in a rapidly changing culture. I have the resources that were presented at the conference for anyone interested.

Kathy and I will be leading a trip to the Holy Land NEXT year, October 7-16, 2024. Anyone

interested in going or anyone interested in getting more information about the trip should plan on attending an informational meeting on Sunday, October 1st from 5:30-7:00 PM at LifePoint Church in Seneca. We are THRILLED to announce that our tour guide, Avi Ben Yosef, will be in the states and will be sharing all about the trip at that meeting. Avi is by far the best tour guide in all of Israel, and we are so blessed that he will be visiting the states in October and available to attend this informational meeting. The meeting will be held at LifePoint Church as there are a couple other groups from the upstate going to Israel in 2024 and we are all meeting together that evening to hear from Avi.

Kathy and I would LOVE for you to make plans now to attend this meeting as well as prayerfully consider being a part of our October 2024 trip to the Holy Land. The trip cost is \$4500 per person. A \$500 deposit is required at registration. \$1000 is due June 9, 2024 and the balance is due July 9, 2024.
