



## Prisoner Packets for South Carolina

### Prisoner Packet Collection at Beaverdam Mission Center

**Drop off days: November 25 and 26**

Include only these items approved by the SC Department of Corrections:

- In a one-gallon size bag (press and seal or slider) place:
- One black non-retractable pen (no wire clips, no other color ink)
- One 5x8 junior legal pad, white or yellow paper (no wire bound books, composition style books, journals, or post it notes)
- One adult toothbrush (individually factory sealed; no multi-packs, holder, floss, folding travel size)
- One 4 oz. to 6 oz. toothpaste (no travel size)
- One 3.2 oz. to 6 oz. bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped/unboxed)
- Two rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, or Breath Savers (no Smarties, Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, TicTacs)
- Two first-class #10 stamp-embossed envelopes (from USPS – no regular stamps or other size envelopes)

Please do not include extra items. A Christmas card and Scripture booklet will be added to the packets by the state convention. Contact BBA with any questions regarding the items for Prisoner Packets.

As we close out the month of October and enter into the month of November, I want to remind everyone of the one hundred thirty-eighth Annual Meeting of the Beaverdam Baptist Association that will be held on Sunday, October 27 at College Street Baptist Church. Pre-session music will begin at 5:45 PM and the meeting will be called to order at 6:00 PM. We are thrilled to have Dr. Tony Wolfe, Executive Director-Treasurer of the South Carolina Baptist Convention, as our guest speaker.

We are still in need of additional participants in order for us to be able to offer the Pastors Re Cohort leadership track. We presently have three pastors committed to this training and need at least one more participant in order to offer the training. There is no cost involved and each participant will receive approximately \$150 worth in books as a part of the class. Re Cohort is a 13-month pastoral leadership training designed to strengthen both the pastor and the church he leads. Participants will experience 13 lessons designed to equip them to lead God's people to refocus on God's mission as we trust Christ to build His Church. The Re-Cohort group meets one day a month from 9:00 – 12:00. Topics to be covered include: Prayer; Biblical Leadership; Gospel Centrality & Marks of a Healthy Church; Vision & Values; Evangelism/Missional Engagement; Preaching & Teaching; Discipleship & Member Care; Congregational Worship; Developing Leaders; Polity & Processes; Adversity; Perseverance & Partnerships; and Multiplication & Sending. I want to say "thank you" for the overwhelming response to our recent Western North Carolina Disaster Relief effort. The churches that we have been ministering to will be contacting us with a new list of needs as soon as their supplies start to run low. Again, thank you so very much for your support of this relief effort.
