From the Associational Mission Strategist (AMS),

This message is an URGENT REQUEST to every pastor and every church in the Beaverdam Baptist Association. We need your help!

We have all heard the stories and we're all familiar with the statistics provided by Lifeway Research regarding declining churches and churches facing closure. When I was called as the DOM/AMS of this association back in 2010, my first DOM meeting at the Baptist building in Columbia focused on helping churches close with dignity. My heart was burdened when I left Columbia that day as I thought about the responsibility involved with helping churches become legacy churches.

As I have shared on numerous occasions, in BBA we have twenty-four churches who average 40 people or less each Sunday. Of those twenty-four churches, eleven of them are running 20 or less each week. In my fifteen years as AMS of Beaverdam Baptist Association we have seen member churches decide to become legacy churches and make the decision to close with dignity. Within the next few years other BBA churches will be forced to make similar heartbreaking decisions regarding their future.

My heart breaks as I listen to the the precious saints that make up these churches share memories of the glory years as the tears roll down their cheeks. The emotions and heartbreak are real and painful as they face the reality that their outlook for the future seems bleak.

This is where church partnerships can be such a blessing to both the struggling church and the partnering church. I believe that it is critically important that we as an association:

- (1) Address this critical need within our association
- (2) Encourage churches to prayerfully consider entering into a partnership with a sister church
- (3) Understand that church partnerships are biblical

On Thursday, January 9 from 10:30 to 12:30, I want to ask every pastor and every church to make a special effort to be a part of a conversation (lunch will be provided) on church partnerships at the Beaverdam Mission Center. We will be sharing information on what a partnership looks like for both the partnering church and the receiving church. We currently have a church that is earnestly and prayerfully seeking a partnership with a sister

The association collected 1,791 prisoner packets in November. The association WMU team donated 215 packets for Oconee Detention Center, totaling 2,006.

New Hope Baptist Church and Holly Springs Baptist Church collected 5,293 shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child. The Foothills Area Team (Oconee/Pickens) reported a total of 26,887 shoeboxes collected.
