In agreement with Scripture, churches all across the SBC/SCBC are coming alongside sister churches in partnerships with a goal to strengthen declining churches while impacting communities with the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ. In our own association, we have seen the hand of God work in mighty ways in the "Fostering" partnership between Retreat Baptist Church and Cheohee Baptist Church. Below are just a few of the blessings that have already been experienced in that particular partnership:


- Average attendance at Retreat has increased from 16 to 34 in four weeks.
- Retreat now has 5 children in a nursery that has not been used in years.
- The Retreat Baptist Church congregation has been so encouraged.
- Average attendance is 20 at the Thursday evening Prayer Meeting/Bible Study.
- Retreat has seen visitors present for every Sunday morning service.
- A joint Easter Sunrise Service was held with 78 in attendance.
- The church has established 10 internal goals as well as 10 external goals.
- Church polices/processes are being evaluated and updated.
- A new playground will be installed soon.
- VBS is scheduled this summer for the first time in years.
- Audio-Visual upgrades have taken place.

Recently, Shiloh Baptist Church (1320 Shiloh Road, Seneca) voted unanimously to request a "Fostering Relationship - Partnership" with another BBA church. This is HUGE step for a church to take and I am so proud of the precious people who make up Shiloh Baptist Church for their obedience and desire to become a healthier, more effective New Testament body of believers.
